Welcome to the Aggie Reader

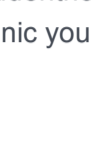
Hello, New Aggie! You're receiving this email because you have a 2021-2022 Student Housing and Dining Services residence hall or apartment contract.

COVID-19 and Move In

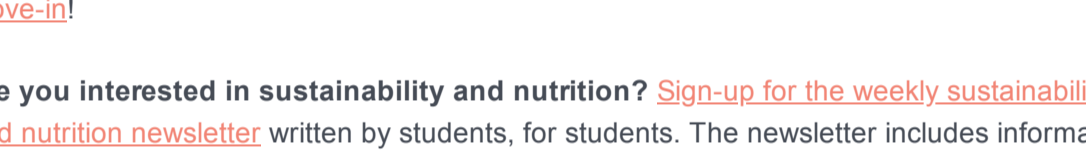

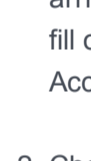

Food Allergies? Dietary Restrictions? We've Got Your Back.

Here's what you can do if you have food allergies or dietary restrictions:

1. Disclose your Food Allergies! We highly encourage students to disclose their food allergies or dietary restrictions as soon as possible to ensure peace of mind when they arrive on campus. Visit and read the Housing and Dining Accommodations webpage, fill out the Disability Disclosure found on that page, then submit it to our Accommodations Specialists at specialaccom@ad3.ucdavis.edu.
2. Check out our [Online Menu](#) for all information on ingredients, allergens, and nutrition. We label for the Top 8 major food allergens, as well as sesame, coconut, and mushrooms.

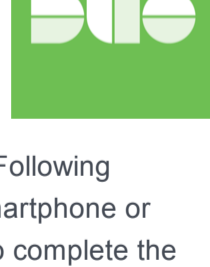

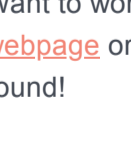

New student enrollment in Duo

Duo is a multi-factor authentication app that makes it much harder for hackers to access your UC Davis accounts. Even if someone has stolen your passphrase, they need a "second factor" — in most cases a temporary numeric code, to access your account.



New students who have signed their Intent to Register and set up their computing account were enrolled in Duo automatically in July. Following enrollment, new students will still need to take the steps to register their smartphone or device to use Duo.
